### HISTORY as on 2010 March 6

In 1983, the necessity for forming an association for educational research dawned on the minds of some researchers carrying out their work at the Centre of Advanced Study in Education, at the MS University of Baroda, Vadodara, Gujarat. They prepared byelaws for registration of the Association. As it could not be possible to have persons from Vadodara take up the responsibility of the proposed Indian Educational Research Association could not be registered there. A cyclostyled publication- A Few Useful Journals and Educational Organizations compiled by S.B. Mohanty as the first publication of this unregistered association. Its second publication "Bibliography on Student Teaching" by SB Mohanty was brought out in 1987 with its cover page printed by Late Dr. D. K. Sharma of JV Jain College, Saharanpur, Uttar Pradesh. MR. mohit Mohan Mohanty of SCS College, Puri, Orissa got the materials cyclostyled. This effort of Dr Sharma made SB Mohanty to try again for the formation registration of the Association. In 1987, he convened an informal meeting of a few educationists of Bhubaneswar, Orissa at the residence of Dr. Surendra Nath Panda, the then Field Adviser of NCERT for Orissa. Prof. Suresh Chandra Chaturvedi at that time working at the Regional College (now Institute) of Education of NCERT, Bhubaneswar volunteered to become the host and sign the invitation letter sent for inaugural meeting of the proposed association. On 8<sup>th</sup> November 1987, the meeting was held at the Govt. Boys' High School located at Unit IX, Bhubaneswar. Dr. Dhruva Charan Mishra, the present Treasurer of AIAER, at that time a Lecturer in Education took up the responsibility for organised the meeting that was held in the building of Unit IX High School, Bhubaneswar, Orissa. The draft rules and regulation etc. necessary for the registration of the Association were finalized and the signatures of applicants were taken. All participants, except two, were from Orissa. Outside Orissa participants were Mrs. Neeti Kishore Pradhan, Retired Principal (at that time a Lecturer) of Chembur Comprehensive College of Education, Mumbai and late Dr T.P.Gupta of J. N. Degree College, Lucknow. Prof. S.C. Chaturvedi became the first President of the Association. The Association was registered under Societies' Registration Act at Bhubaneswar on 17<sup>th</sup> November 1987. A number of educationists interested in educational research have been instrumental in the growth of the Association. At the time of registration, AIAER office was located at 2RB 3/8, Kalpana Flat, the residence of Dr. D. C. Mishra, the then Treasurer (also present Treasurer). After a few years, Association office was shifted to 106/1502 Acharya Vihar, the residence of Dr. M. D. Panda, then a Reader in Regional Institute of Education, Bhubaneswar. Now it is located at N1/55 IRC Village, Bhubaneswar - 751 015, the residence of Prof. Prafulla Chandra Mohapatra, Ex-Director, Teacher Education & SCERT, Govt. of Orissa. Thus, the association has been functioning from residences of the members interested in promoting educational research. Dr. N. K. Patil, the then Principal of Chembur Comprehensive College of Education, Mumbai was instrumental in taking out the activities of the association to out side Orissa, the State where it took birth. Late Dr. (Miss) T. K. Jayalakshmi, the then Principal of R.V. Teachers' College, Bangalore organised the next annual conference. She succeeded in making the ailing veteran educational researcher Prof. M. B. Buch, come all the way from Baroda to Bangalore, to give direction to the Association. At Bangalore meeting Prof. Buch became the 1<sup>st</sup> Patron of the AIAER. Earlier, Prof. Buch had been involved in the hrowth of the Association. He had requested Dr. (Ms.) M. D. Bengalee, Ex VC of University of Bombay to attend the 2<sup>nd</sup> annual conference at Cuttack and had asked SB Mohanty, AIAER General Secretary to have Dr. Bengalee as the President of the Association. Dr Bengalee could not attend the meeting and expressed her inability to become the President. However, she became a life member of the Association. During Bangalore Conference, Dr. Buch desired that the three organisations, with which he was involved - Society for Educational Research and Development, Baroda; All India Association for Educational Technology, New Delhi and All India Association for Educational Research, Bhubaneswar could bring out quarterly journals in a manner so that an individual, who was a member of each of these three organizations, could get one journal every month. He requested some of the old students of CASE, Baroda present at the meeting to take care of advertisements for AIAER journal. However, although registered as a Quarterly, in order to make the journal have more articles and non-availability of advertisements, the AIAER Journal is now being brought out twice a year. AIAER is a

founding member of recently formed World Educational Research Association ([www.weraonline.org](http://www.weraonline.org)). AIAER General Secretary, Sunil Behari Mohanty, is AIAER representative in WERA Council. AIAER has also become a member of Asia Pacific Educational Research Association. Prof. Suraj Prakash Malhotra, President, AIAER had been invited to attend last meeting of APERA held at Singapore. As Prof. Malhotra could not attend it, AIAER General Secretary, who was at Singapore to attend WERA meeting, represented AIAER at APERA meeting.
