

**AIAER PAPER WRITING WORKSHOPS ON WRITING  
RESEARCH PAPERS / SCHOLARLY ARTICLES**

All India Association for Educational Research has been conducting workshops on writing research paper / scholarly articles at different places in the country. One day workshops have been organised at Una (Himachal Pradesh), Saharanpur, and Mohali (Punjab), Chennai (Tamil Nadu), Maya Bunder (A& N Islands), and at Kalyan (Maharashtra). Two day workshops have been organised at Puducherry, Mysore and Chitradurga (Karnataka), Tiruninravur (Tamil Nadu), and at Lucknow and Mathura (Uttar Pradesh) and Kolkata, West Bengal. Out of these workshops, Chitradurga and Maya Bunder workshops had teachers of various subjects of the host colleges. In case of Kolkata workshop, there were a few participants who were teaching subjects other than Education. Activities in the workshops include: General Guidelines (Power Point Presentation); Varieties of Reference Styles (Discussing the Workshop Reading Material); APA Manual (Power Point Presentation); Supervised Reading of articles in a Few Good Foreign Journals and a few Indian Journals; Review of a printed article (each participant to have one -Marking can be made - Article to be carried home); Reporting of Review ( A few participants to initiate and others to join); Converting the references in the article into different styles- APA, MLA, University of Chicago and Journal of AIAER; Peer review of conversions, and finally Improving one's own manuscript (if one has not brought one's own manuscript, a manuscript by an anonymous author is provided).
